

Every year, Texas Tech Parents Association awards thousands of dollars in student scholarships. Scholarship applications are available in four categories: entering freshmen, returning undergraduate students, new transfers, and graduate students. TTPA scholarships are awarded based on a variety of factors including academic merit, financial need, field of study, and *quality of essays*. 


